

CADERNOS DO GEEvH

Guide for Authors

The *Cadernos do GEEvH* accepts manuscripts written in Portuguese, Castilian and English from several fields such as anthropology, archaeology, primatology, biology or others that generally or specifically focus on the subject of Human Evolution. Several types of manuscripts are accepted: original article; case study; letter to the editors; systematic revision/state of the art; critical review; meta-analysis paper; monograph; work in progress; and posters presented at scientific meetings.

Each submission must state the type of the paper. Microsoft Word or an equivalent word processor must be used to write the manuscript. The text must be double-spaced; the margins must have 3 cm; the font is Calibri 12 pt; and the manuscript must not exceed 8000 words (including tables and references). The paper should include the following information:

- Title of the paper;
- Name of the authors;
- Institutional affiliation and the e-mail addresses of the correspondent author and all the other co-authors;
- Abstract (limit of 200 words) and keywords (max. 6) on at least two languages (one must be in Portuguese – ask the editors for help if Portuguese is not your native tongue). Abstract and keywords are not required for letters to the editors and critical reviews;
- Each section of the paper must be preceded by a subtitle written in bold (e.g.: **Introduction, Material and Methods**);
- Tables and figures must all be mentioned in the text. Each one of these must have a caption;
- Figures must be in jpg or tiff formats and have a minimum of 300 dpi and their reproduction rights are the responsibility of the author. You may import the figures into the document, but submit them as separate files as well.
- The amount of footnotes must be reduced to the minimum;
- Bibliography mentioned in the text should be presented according to the following examples: one author (Malinowski, 1927); two authors (Bogin and Malina, 2001); and three or more authors (Smith *et al.*, 2001);
- Semicolon must be used to separate two or more references (Waldron, 1994; Cockburn, 2000) or papers from the same author (Dias, 1998; 1999). References from consulted bibliography must be mentioned as the following example (Martín, 1901 *in* Neto, 1957);

- Citations in the text must include hyperlinks directing the reader to the respective reference in the list at the end of the manuscript;
- References mentioned in the text (and only these) must be alphabetically ordered at the end of the manuscript as the following:
